moved in a procedure called "a buccal fat pad excision" that is done through the inside of the mouth. "These two procedures highlight the cheeks and sculpt the face," says the doc. His advice to the daughter of Demi Moore and Bruce Willis? "Don't do anything else." Actually, the young beauty is cagey about doing anything at all: "If I choose to do something to myself, I've thought about it," asserts Rumer. "And if it's going to make me feel better, I won't be ashamed!" LS

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FOREHEAD

Botox has raised Rumer's eyebrows to a high arch, says Dr. Kally Papantoniou. Expect to pay \$500-\$1K every three months for injections.

EYES

"Her eyes look less heavy and tired, which is due to some good Botox," praises Dr. Lyle Back, who does not treat the actress. Cost: \$600 every four months.

NOSE

Dr. Steve Fallek, who doesn't treat Rumer, says her "nose looks narrower around the bridge," adding, "she definitely had work done there." Price tag: \$6K.

LIPS

Rumer's lips are "fuller and more luscious" because of dermal fillers, says Dr. Papantoniou. A plumper pout runs about \$600-\$1K every six months.
